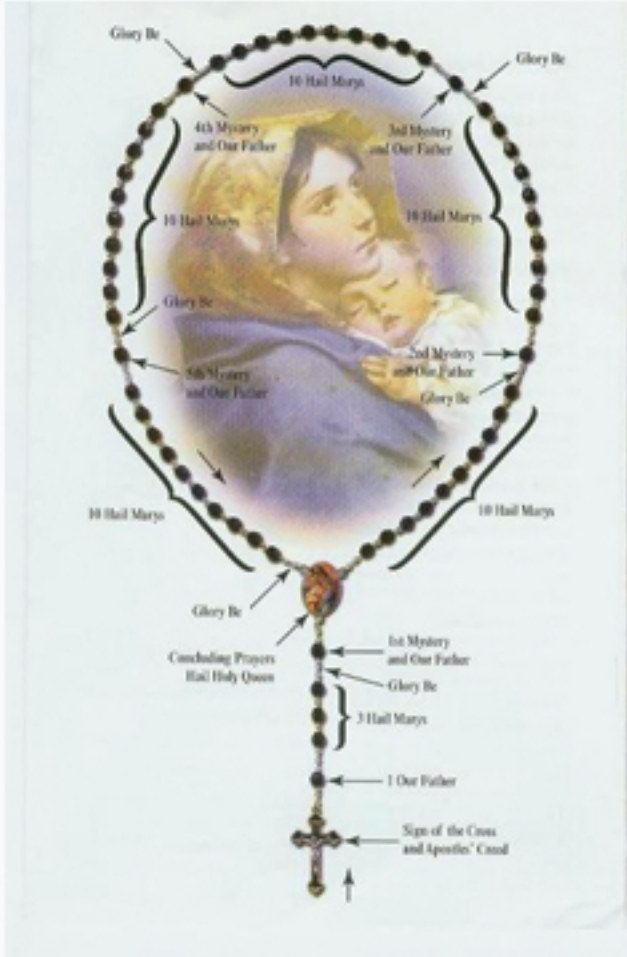


A Rosary for Life

How to pray the Holy Rosary



1. Make the Sign of the Cross and say the Apostles' Creed.
2. Pray the Our Father.
3. Pray three Hail Marys.
4. Pray the Glory Be to the Father.
5. Present your intentions to Our Lady; introduce the title of the First Mystery and begin by praying the Our Father.
6. Then follow with ten Hail Marys, while meditating on the Mystery.
7. Conclude the Mystery with the Glory Be to the Father and the O My Jesus.
8. Repeat steps 5, 6 and 7 for the Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth Mysteries.
9. After completing the five Mysteries finish with the Hail, Holy Queen and the Concluding Prayer of the Rosary and close with the Sign of the Cross.

The Apostles' Creed

from thence He shall come to judge the living and the dead.
I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints,
the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body and Life Everlasting.

To thee do we cry, poor banished children of Eve; to thee do we send up our sighs,
mourning and weeping in this valley of tears. Turn then, most gracious advocate,
thine eyes of mercy toward us and after this our exile, show unto us the blessed fruit of
thy womb, Jesus. O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary.*
